- Immediate attention is needed on the fields and the surrounding area. We all agreed it is necessary to spend budgeted money for gravel for the entrance of the fields so it doesn't look so shabby. Also to request volunteers to clean up and paint the building. There was a suggestion we use the youth from Arrowhead School or from Livingston High School.

Action Items:

- 1. Ask the Board to use leftover budgeted money for gravel and buying paint.
- 2. Volunteers to clean out the existing building or asking youth from nearby schools utilizing the school's work program.
